

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2006

A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH THE FIRST THURSDAY AFTER THE FOURTH TUESDAY IN MAY AS THE DATE FOR THE ANNUAL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF ASSESSMENT REVIEW, PURSUANT TO SECTION 512(1-a) OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ALLEGANY, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is the desire of the Town Board of the Town of Allegany to establish the first Thursday after the Fourth Tuesday in May as the date for annual meetings of the board of assessment review for the hearing of complaints.

Section 2. It is the further desire of the Town Board of the Town of Allegany, NY to establish the first Thursday after the Fourth Tuesday in May, 2007 as the date of the first such annual meetings of the board of assessment review, and so many days thereafter as the board of assessment review deems necessary for the hearing of complaints in relation to assessments, pursuant to this Local Law.

Section 3. This Local Law shall be filed in the office of the New York State Secretary of State upon the passage of this local law by the Town of Allegany, NY.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State.
