Town of Allegany Proposed Solar Energy Local Law

Arby's/A & T Development – 1779 Gargoyle Rd.

There has not been any movement on this proposed project since the Board granted Site Plan approval and issuance of Special Use Permit on October 3, 2022.

The Building and Zoning Department is awaiting a full application packet for issuance of a Building Permit.

Community Bank/Clark Patterson Lee – 3152 NYS Rt 417

A complete Building Permit application has been received by the Building and Zoning Department and is under review for issuance.

Comprehensive Plan Grant

The final determination of the Comprehensive Plan Grant award through the Department of State is still pending.

New Business

Wind Energy Proposals

Liberty Renewables and Terr-Gen are two renewable energy companies that have expressed interest in developing projects within the Town of Allegany's jurisdiction. These projects would be permitted through New York State, not at the Town level.

Water Shed Overlay District

Board members discussed the proposed creation of a Water Shed Overlay District that is in step for a final report. Chairman Hellier discussed the need for signage on Buffalo Rd., NYS Rt 86, and the Five Mile Rd.

Town Hall Technology Upgrades

Board members discussed the need for technology upgrades at the Town Hall. Ideas included, streaming capabilities, screens and the potential to meet remotely via Zoom.
